It provides teachers and students with the following benefits:

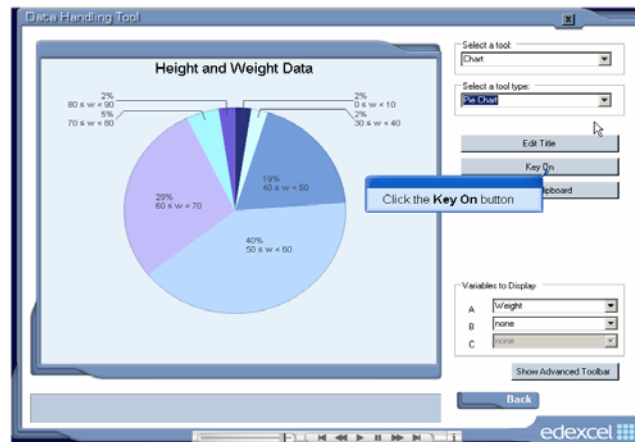
- Reduces time spent on completing coursework
